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

- The correct school uniform must be worn every day. The uniform consists of a white shirt or blouse, crested jumper, black socks, skirt or black trousers, and optional tie.

- Black shoes and ankle boots with no visible logo are required. Heels should be max 3cm and laces must be black. White soles are required for P.E.

- Taster subjects are available to students in first year and transition year.

What are Taster subjects?

- They enable students to try out subjects they may not have previously considered such as Chinese, coding or metalwork in first year, and first aid in transition year.
- Students will derive a good sense of what is involved in each subject area which helps them when making their subject choices.



- Vsware is a mobile based school administration platform through which you can access attendance records, timetables, assessment results and feedback on student behavior.
- Your login will be sent to you at the start of first year. There is a separate Vsware login account for parents and students.

 - The school offers numerous extracurricular activities which teachers volunteer their personal time to facilitate.

What extracurricular activities are available?

- These activities are available before school starts in the morning, during lunch breaks and after school.
- The Extra Curricular Timetable is available on the school website.

Why are classes one hour long?

- Studies have shown that one hour long classes are more productive and enable teachers and students to engage more effectively than shorter
- They also reduce stress for students getting to classes on time and moving
- It also reduces the levels of homework assigned each day.

Is hot food available?

- The school canteen is operational every day. Snacks are available at first break and hot food is available to purchase at lunchtime.
- Note* card payments are now accepted as well as cash in the Canteen.
