Fact 2: Students who do TY do better in Leaving Cert than students who go directly to LC.




Myth 1: 'They lose the habit of study'. Our experience is that this is not true.

Why choose TY?



- Gain useful work experience
- Opportunity to partake in new experiences
- Encouraged to take up new skills or hobbies
- Build confidence and mature into young adults
- Friendships grow during Transition Year
- Think about leaving cert subjects and college choices
- Enhances performance at Leaving Cert
- Better prepared for 3rd level



Better results in Leaving Cert:

■ Students who do TY get an average of 40-45 more points in their Leaving Cert than those who go straight into 5th Year.

Repeat Students only get an average of 5 more points

Aims of Transition Year




- To give students **space and time** to mature, learn, and develop without the pressure of the Leaving Certificate.

TY Costs



- Some TY activities are free of charge
- Many require bus hire
- Some activities require a charge
- Fee of €350 (Paid in instalments)
- ■Annual school charge of €110 is separate to TY fee
- Students pay for their own bus/LUAS fare for local events (LEAP card recommended)
